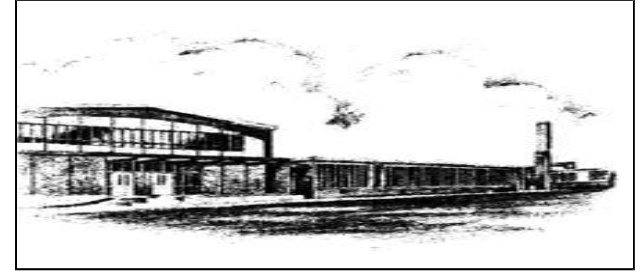


If the Supplemental Levy Fails
